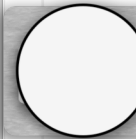

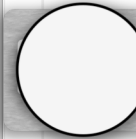

Notebooks

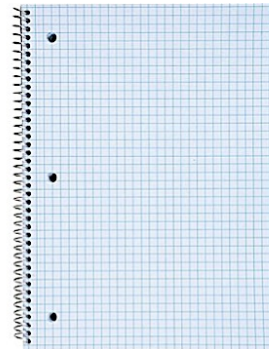
NOTEBOOKS

Our notebooks will be set up based on left to right numbered pages. For each new lesson, you will complete as many pages as necessary in the following format:

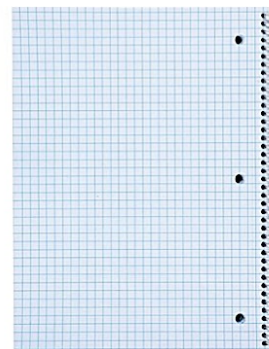
RIGHT SIDE
